- Maximum one page essay describing your interests in the construction industry
- Letter of recommendation from a member of school faculty
- High School or College transcripts
- An interview will be required

SELECTION PROCESS

Scholarship applicants will be notified of the decision by the end of August 2018. Payment will be made to the recipient's school of choice.

AWARD

Up to four annual payments of \$1,000 towards recipient's tuition. (GPA to be verified each year)
